- Acknowledgement of competence due to the specialized knowledge and skills set of LSL and related
 areas (e.g., parent coaching) by parents and other professionals. A recent Academy survey found that
 90% of certified LSL professionals sought certification to improve the services they provided to

- Listing of the LSLS Cert. AVT or LSLS Cert. AVEd credential following your name helps parents, professionals and society identify you as a professional who knows how to teach LSL to children who are deaf or hard of hearing.
- 3. **Promotion of you as a certified LSL professional** in the "Locate an LSLS Directory" on the Academy's website, which could lead to new opportunities.
- 4. **New opportunity** for employment or promotion to higher positions.
