

FAQs for Certified LSL Specialist Mentors

FAQS FOR LSLS MENTORS

May I advocate on behalf of my mentee's eligibility to the Academy or Committee members?

No. The role of the mentor is to provide feedback on the applicant's current skill level within the nine domains of LSLS knowledge, not to advocate on their behalf.

Can I determine my mentee's eligibility to sit for the exam?

No. Once a professional seeking certification has successfully registered in the [LSL Registry](#), the person is eligible to take the certification exam at any point during the three-to-five year certification process. Passing the exam is only one part of achieving certification as a LSL Specialist.

May I charge for my mentoring services?

The decision of whether to charge for mentoring is left up to the individual mentor. We encourage you to discuss this before beginning the mentoring process.

How can I communicate my availability as a LSLS mentor to interested applicants?

Yes. The Locate a Listening and Spoken Language Specialist Directory allows certified LSL Specialists to list their contact information, if they are accepting mentees, if they provide tele-services, and languages spoken.
