

How do I enroll in the LSL Registry?



- Share required documentation
- Create a profile in the LSL Registry
- Provide documentation related to your educational background and your selected LSLS -certified mentor
- Documentation will be reviewed by the Academy within two weeks of completion
- Once you are officially accepted into the LSL Registry, you will be able to begin uploading certification application materials as you complete them.





ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS FOR CERTIFICATION

Credential/licensure - Bachelor's or Master's degree in audiology, speech-language pathology and/or education of children who are DHH. (Other degrees by negotiation).

Continuing education - minimum of 80 hours

A formal written description of LSL Auditory-Verbal Practice

Professional experience - 900 clock hours of professional experience in provision of LSLS practice within the past three to five years. At least 750 of these hours must be in direct therapy (incl. 10% rehabilitation for adults with a new device). Plus a maximum of 150 in related activities.

Mentoring by a <u>certified</u> LSL professional - Minimum of 20 sessions over 3 - 5 years (+ 10 observations of LSLS Certs)

Two parent letters of recommendation

Two professional letters of recommendation







Examinations are held at Kryterion Testing Centers Worldwide

Candidates have four hours to take the exam.

How is a passing score determined?

A passing score is determined on the number of items answered correctly on the 175 multiple choice test questions

If I don't pass the exam, may I take it again?

- Complete the service form requesting to retake the exam
- You may take the test up to three (3) times before you must resubmit an application
- Minimum 3 month (90 day) waiting period in between each exam attempt.
